The Area

The area consists of waterways, woodland, steep banks, a dried up pond and some old concrete structures.

Ideas

- Area for local schools to come and experience the local wildlife
- Return the pond to a wildlife friendly area and encourage biodiversity

Plants

Lewisham Council and Natures Gym identified the following species:

Ground elder, common hogweed, bramble, wild perennial rocket, buddleia, bristly oxtongue, Japanese knotweed, scarlet, common toadflax, great willow herb, black medic, woody nightshade, goose grass, jersey fleabane, persicaria, mugwort, stinging nettle, white dead nettle, white campion, tansy, Michaelmas daisy and bindweed..

Wildlife

The area provides an ideal habitat for many bugs, birds and mammals. Fox cubs were a common sight during the clean up day. The large woody area provides excellent cover for many birds.
