Lee Manor Community Garden group have a lease from LB Lewisham to grow fruit and vegetables. During several gardening sessions this Spring energetic community gardeners have built raised beds, sowed seeds and started to plant the garden.



The four raised beds are planted with root crops; beans; brassicas; and herb and salad crops and there is a builders bag with peas. The next major plan is to build a garden shed that will provide the group with storage space and also allow the harvesting of rainwater from the roof into water butts.
